**Student Survey Results** - Elem 4-6 the bullying had a 20% decrease from the May June. Feel safe had a 20% increase. Sense of belonging had a 12% increase. Valuing school outcomes 14%. Life satisfaction had a 12% increase. Highschool - School outcomes was an increase of 9%. The truancy had a 12% decrease. Effort had a 12% increase. Intellectual engagement had a 17% increase. Goal orientation had a 20% increase. Career preparation was 20% above the Canadian norm. Frequency of career exploration and planning were all significantly above the Canadian norm. Positive relationships is below norm. Sense of belonging has increased. Positive learning environment was below Canadian norm.
