This concept originated out of North Battleford and has spread across the province. Community members wore Better Together t-shirts looking for logo matches on Tuesdays. The project began with 300 students and seniors and has expanded to over 65,000 shirts worn across the country.

The outcomes of these connections are: mutual understanding, improved feelings of well-being, decreased loneliness, satisfaction from sharing knowledge and experience, and enhanced social cohesion.

Our journey so far has included a kick-off assembly with the founder of the program, purchasing t-shirts for all the students, and creating partnerships within the community.
